The kettle can be removed from the base to refill, or it can be left on the base and filled using a jug through the large hinged opening on the lid.

The kettle has an ergonomic sage grip handle shape to assist with grasp.

The kettle is a quiet boil with auto shut -off to prevent the unit from over heating. Removable anti-scale filter.

The kettle is left in the base and tipped rather than lifted to pour the water into the cup. The tipper has a non slip base to reduce the unit from moving when being poured.
